



# DAVE BALDWIN 2006



*Dave Baldwin* has participated in the Elkhart Bowling Association since 1962, when he was at Red Crown Lanes with a 127 average. In 2001 Dave brought his average to 208 and has kept his average at more than 200 for each year since. Currently his average at Oakland Lanes is approximately 90 pins over the 1962 average. In 1968 Dave was the Doubles Scratch and Handicap Champion with his partner Sam Wagner. The following year they repeated as Handicap Champions and finished second in scratch. In 2000 Dave was Handicap Singles, Handicap All Events, Senior Singles, Senior All Events, and with partner Dan Atkinson, Handicap Doubles Champion. In addition to participating locally, Dave has also participated in several State and National events.

During this time he has done far more than participate. He has held the offices of 4th, 3rd, 2nd, and 1st Vice Presidents from 1988 to 1991 and became President in 1992. He then remained on the Board of Directors and became the Assistant Secretary in 1998 and has continued to do so. Dave dedicates many hours of service to the Bowling Association to this day.

*Dave* has shown himself to be a great ambassador of the sport. He encourages people who are down and congratulates both teammates and competitors when they perform well.
