Betty has been bowling in sanctioned leagues for over 48 years in Elkhart and Goshen. She started in a junior league in Missouri at the age of 12 years old.

She has participated in 25 USBC State Tournaments and 19 USBC National Tournaments.

She has bowled in both scratch and handicap leagues. Also was a director on the Elkhart Women's Bowling Association Board, serving on the Hall of Fame committee, working the city tournament and the Higley Mixed tournament, also compiling a booklet of statistics of the women bowlers in Elkhart.

Betty's bowling accomplishments are many: she has a high game of 300, high series of 721. Her highest average is 194. She has won in the city tournament: 5 scratch team championships, 2 handicap team championships, 2 scratch doubles championships, 1 scratch and 1 handicap singles championship, 2 scratch and 3 handicap all-events championships, 2 scratch and 1 handicap seniors all-events championships, and 1 scratch and 1 handicap seniors singles championships. She has championed the Higley Appliance Mixed Tournament in 1996 with Christel Hughey, Rich Hughey, Dan Hoffman, and that same year won the scratch doubles portion of the tournament with Dan Hoffman. Betty was Bowler of the month in April 1986, April 1993, and October 1994. She won the Truth Roll-Off in 1993. All of these accomplishments are in a range of years from 1986 to 2006.
