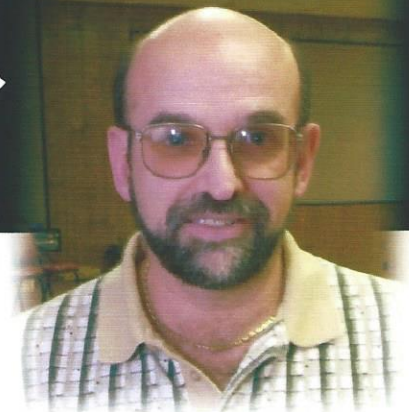

JIM ARTLEY Jr. 2003



Jim Artley Jr. has been bowling in leagues for 42 years since he started in 1961 at the age of 5 at Maple City Lanes in Goshen, Indiana.

Jim attended Concord High School and graduated in 1973 where he was a four-year letterman in golf. Jim is the son of Jim Artley and Donna Winner, he is also a sibling to three brothers and two sisters. Jim has a lovely wife, Stephanie, and has two children of his own. His daughter Jamie and his son Jeff. They both attended Elkhart Central High School.

Jim bowled 769 (247, 244, 278) for his first 700 series in 1975 at the age of 19. Two years later at the age of 21 he won the MBA Championship in Niles, MI. defeating Val Medich Sr. 221-220. In 1979 Jim had his first 800 series of 808 (256, 254, 298) at Country Club Lanes. Then in 1980 Jim rolled his first 300 game at Country Club Lanes and has since rolled 36-300 games.

Jim's bowling accomplishments are:

- 8 City Tournament Team Championships, 3-2nds in doubles (with Dick Veloz), 1-2nd place singles and 1-2nd place all events.
- Elkhart Truth Roll Off Qualifier for 28 years
- Elkhart Truth Roll Off Champion in 1997
- Elkhart Truth Roll Off Runner-up in 1980 & 1981 (to Dick Veloz both years)
- Set City High Series of 857 on December 8, 1992 which held for 9+ years
- 3-MBA Titles 36-300's 30-800's
- 2 seasons with 5-300's (1995-96, 2001-02)
- 4 seasons with 3-800's
- City High Average 15 times, City High Series 13 times
