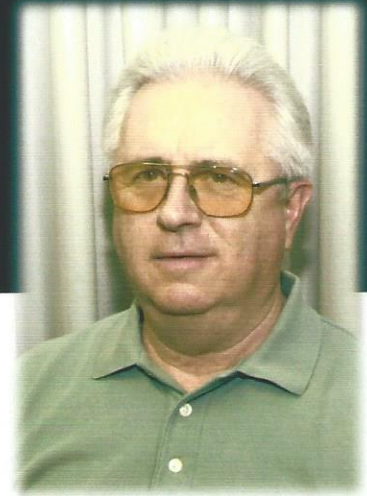


# TERRY FAIR 2004
