Jerry Healey Sr. has been bowling for 49 years, starting in the junior league program at O.C. Lanes at the age of 13 (1954). Jerry married Annette Healey in 1961 and has two sons, Jerry Jr. and Christopher. He has two daughters-in-laws (Tina and Kim) and the biggest blessing in his family is his granddaughter Jessica. In 1954 (age 13), he was setting pins at the local bowling center by hand. In 1957 (age 16), while still in the junior league program his team won the Indiana State Junior League Tournament. In 1960, at age 18 he started bowling in men's leagues 5 nights a week. He has bowled on many winning teams in Elkhart, Mishawaka, and South Bend. One of his fondest memories was bowling back-to-back 700's in the Sugar Sweeper at the P.N.A. Club in South Bend, with a series of 1430. Jerry joined the PBA tour in 1988 and Senior PBA tour in 1991.
